



IMMIGRATION AND REFUGEE SETTLEMENT IN CANADA: TRENDS IN PUBLIC FUNDING

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HIGHLIGHTS

- Federal government provides funding only for Permanent Residents
- Provincial funding also supports temporary foreign workers, refugee claimants, international students and naturalized citizens.
- The numbers of newcomers admitted to Canada is increasing.
- Provincial funding has been static or declined except for a brief increase due to the influx of Syrian refugees.
- Federal funding through IRCC has increased over the past decade.



Funding by province 2011-2017




PROVINCIAL FUNDING






Federal funds by province (2016)
